<b>Biblical Basis</b>	1 Timothy 3:8-13; Titus 2:6-8; Acts 6
<b>Position Objective</b>	Deacons display servant leadership to the church body through being shepherds, stewards, and servants as we strive to present every person compete in Christ.
<b>Key Responsibilities &amp; Duties</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>1. Serve God’s church as a part of the Shepherd, Steward, or other ministry teams.</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Participate with the elders, Senior Pastor, and other deacons in serving through shepherding our LIFE Group leadership and/or stewarding our church resources.</li><li>• Participate in shepherd, steward, or other leadership/ministry gatherings as appropriate and depending on where you are connected based on your gifts.</li><li>• These venues are the primary avenues at Blackhawk Ministries for deacon ministry, but there are many more platforms for the servant leadership roles of deacon ministry as well.</li></ul></li><li><b>2. Serve God’s church through active ministry participation</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Lead the way by being visibly “bought in” at Blackhawk, championing our ministry in every way possible so to be catalyst for unity within our church family.</li><li>• Perform ministry duties for church-wide initiatives such as communion, counseling with those making decisions, and other duties as requested.</li><li>• Actively find places to engage in ministry through Blackhawk’s current ministry initiatives. Lead the way in involvement, participation, and presence in our ministry efforts.</li><li>• Be a part of a LIFE Group where you can grow with and alongside those you are called to serve.</li><li>• Participate in the interview process for prospective church members as requested.</li><li>• Participate in the church discipline process as requested.</li></ul></li><li><b>3. Serve God’s church through personal integrity and example</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Exemplify our values and intent by keeping the biblical standards for a deacon, striving to be a role model by the indwelling power of the Holy Spirit.</li><li>• “Attach oneself” to a ministry in which to serve and shepherd those in our care.</li><li>• Pray regularly for our staff, our family, and all ministries.</li></ul></li></ol>
