Participate on Shepherd Team, Steward Team, Preaching Team, Mission Team, Blackhawk Christian School Board, or other teams as requested. Perform role of Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary or other officer role as requested. Participate in board development and succession initiatives, including the annual selection and affirmation of new elders. Participate in overseeing and evaluating the performance of the Senior Pastor, and evaluating the performance of the elder board; intentionally participate in various ministry functions in order to fulfill this responsibility. 	 Able and inclined to teach the Bible. Provide spiritual supervision for Blackhawk Ministries. Oversee, provide feedback for, and consistently "safeguard" our teaching ministry. Uphold and enforce our bylaws, constitution, and articles of faith. Participate in the church discipline process as required.
