Position Summary

The Associate Pastor role is a non-teaching position focused on pastoral care, adult ministries, and our Best Impressions team. We are seeking a man of God who will officiate weddings and funerals, perform baptisms, and provide pastoral care. The Associate Pastor will serve as oversight and point of contact for various adult ministries. He is also responsible for the support and development of a systematic and effective approach to Gospel-centered connections and assimilation (preferably based on the Fusion system by Nelson Searcy). The ideal candidate will be a caring shepherd with some leadership/administrative giftings. He will display excellent interpersonal and communication skills, a capacity to facilitate relational connections, and an ability to motivate leaders and teams to accomplish the task of caring for and connecting people. This is a non-preaching position, with limited Sunday teaching responsibilities. *We have two Associate Pastor positions open - this one is more general focused on pastoral care, connections, and assimilation, and the other is focused on overseeing our small group ministry.
